

2019 USA KARATE™ FEDERATION HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

2019 ADMINISTRATOR AND OFFICIAL CRITERIA

The individual must have made exceptional contributions that have furthered the growth, reputation and character of the sport of karate, been active for a number of years on a national or international level. This includes individuals who defined the nature of the sport or its competitive spirit, or contributed to make special contributions, in the context of their day.

2019 ATHLETE CRITERIA

The nominee must have represented the highest level of competition, sportsmanship, integrity, character and ability. They should be amongst the finest players that USA Karate Federation had "playing at a Hall of Fame level." Considerations included:

Years Active as a Competitor Competition at US Team Trials Competition at Pan-American Activities in State or Local Competition Competition at National Level Competition at International Cups Activities at Training Camps
Competition at World Championships
Total and Quality of Medals Earned

2019 COACH CRITERIA

Championships

The nominee must have been active on the national level as part of the coaching staff of the USA Karate Federation and who represented the highest level of competition, sportsmanship, integrity, and character and made a major contribution to the development of the USA Karate Federation National Team.

2019 OFFICIALS CRITERIA

The nominee must have represented the highest level of integrity, character and ability. They should be amongst the finest referees and judges that USA Karate Federation had participating on either a national or international level.

2019 POLICE SELF-DEFENSE INSTITUTE HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

Criteria for admission to the PSDI Hall of Fame Includes longstanding involvement in Law Enforcement Defensive Tactics Instruction/Training and recognized:

Expertise

Reputation

Commitment

2019 United States Jujitsu Federation Awards

Determined by USJJF criteria.

USA Karate Federation and PSDI 2019 Pioneer Awards

Determined by CTA criterea.

CENTRAL TAEKWONDO ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

Given to those already in the USA Karate or PSDI Hall of Fame. USA Karate Pioneer awards are specifically to recognize contribution to the development of Olympic Karate in the USA as part of George E Anderson's efforts in these organizations from 1978 to 2009 when he passed.

KWANMUKAN HALL OF FAME

Recognition of those who helped Hanshi George E Anderson in the development and activities of the style of martial arts he founded as the Kwanmukan. This Hall of Fame also recognizes those who have contributed to the further success of this organization.

THE USA KARATE™ FEDERATION HALL OF FAME HISTORY

Since 1976, the USA Karate Federation through itself and its forerunner AAU/USA Karate has recognized those who have made significant contributions to the Olympic Karate movement. In 1997 other SIGNIFICANT NATIONAL MARTIAL ARTS FEDERATIONS decided to have their Hall of Fame inductees honored along with those of the USAKF. In the past, honorees of the US Ju-Jitsu Federation, the USKA Law Enforcement Division (PSDI), the US Kobudo Federation (World Kobudokan), Global Martial Arts Federations, and the Central Taekwondo World Tae Kwon Do Chang Moo Kwan have participated in the USA Karate Federation Hall of Fame. At this induction, the Police Self-Defense Institute (PSDI) is participating.

It is not easy to get into the Hall of Fame. Having money, having many students, having good PR --- and all those things DO NOT INFLUENCE our Hall of Fame selection committee. Outstanding achievements and dedicated work of an extraordinary level must be seen. DEDICATION, PERSERVERANCE, SINCERITY, EXCELLENCE and ACHIEVEMENT ARE the keywords.

The USA Karate Federation Hall of Fame began with the efforts of the AAU Karate Committee (which was to become the USAKF) to IDENTIFY those special people who made OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTONS to the progress of karate in the United States of America. Those persons selected were given an annual award. At that time the awards were called—DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD, or, in actuality, the MAN OR WOMAN OF THE YEAR and the ATHLETE OF THE YEAR (the Centurion Award [for athletes]) and the GE Anderson Distinguished Service Award.

From 1976 to 1997, the National Hall of Fame was not formally located, but the ROSTER OF THE RECIPIENTS AND nature of the highly coveted earned honors were STUDIOUSLY MAINTAINED.

In 1996 the USAKF declared the USA Karate Federation National Office in Akron, Ohio a KARATE MUSEUM and the OFFICIAL LOCATION of the Hall of Fame. The Hall of Famers were no longer just talked about, there was now a PLACE where their MEMORABILIA AND TROPHIES of great significance could be kept. Additionally, a world wide web site was DEVISED TO MEMORIALIZE the individual members of the Hall and to make their accomplishments known, a site where everyone could come to view and study the RICH HERITAGE OF OUR ARTS CREATED BY US in this country.

In 2009 with the passing of Hanshi George E. Anderson, the Hall of Fame memorabilia was transferred to the USA National Karate-do Federation. The USA NKF has not moved to institute its Hall of Fame and it is doubtful they would recognize those who USA Karate™ is a registered service mark at the US Patents and Trademarks Office. contributed so much to the USA Olympic Karate Effort under the USA Karate Federation. The USA Karate Federation convened a special Hall of Fame in the Year 2015 to recognize those who have made the contribution upon which the Olympic Karate movement was established in the United States. In 2019 we continue to recognize coaches, athletes, officials and administrators and in addition, we give the Pioneer of USA Karate to those who were important to the Olympic Karate effort in the USA. The AAU Karate movement began about 1970 and the first AAU National Championships took place in Cleveland, Ohio in 1975 – 40 years ago! We come back to Ohio this 44 years later to honor those who have been a part of the journey.

POLICE SURVIVAL AND DEFENSE INSTITUTE

The PSDI (Police Survival & Defense Institute) (Police Self-Defense Institute) was established many ago years under the historic United States Karate Association. Many senior law-enforcement instructors in the US and abroad were trained and certified under the PSDI. Personnel from the Anti-Terrorists Units, Secret Service, FBI, CID, Interpol, Air Marshals, active police officers, sheriff departments, Departments of State, and many other agencies that we cannot name because of information restrictions, trained under the PSDI. Over the years the PSDI has had great influence over the methodology of officer survival and self-defense training. To belong it is necessary to follow the rules and regulations of the society, which begin with the holding of honor, loyalty, courtesy, and respect as vital personal qualities. After the 911 tragedy, the PSDI has moved to assist security efforts, to provide correct and necessary training for the general public and to once again comment on and advise various agencies on sound operational techniques.

The PSDI is authorized by the combined central technical committees of the USA Karate Federation, United States Jujitsu Federation, The World Kobudokan, The Central Taekwondo Association of The World Tae Kwon Do Chang Moo Kwan, The Global Martial Arts Federation, International Karate Instructors Institute, The Kwanmukan International, The Pan American Budo Federation, The Shudokan International, International Bujitsu Research & Development Foundation, and the Historic United States Karate Association which founded the PSDI concept. PSDI is not a martial arts organization but does have many advanced practitioners as members and advisors, and through our sponsoring partners we offer options for martial arts training in karate, jujitsu, taiho-jitsu, taekwondo, kobudo, kung fu, and police training. The Police Self Defense Instructor's certification is a coveted recognition of defensive tactics instructors – both of civilian and of law enforcement programs. In addition to Police Self-Defense, the PSDI has had influence over the years with military self-defense training, personal self-defense training and women's anti-assault programs.
